Take Control of Your Financial Situation!

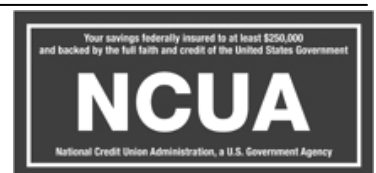
This April through September, CALCOE will be involved in a campaign promoting financial responsibility using CALCOE's products and services.

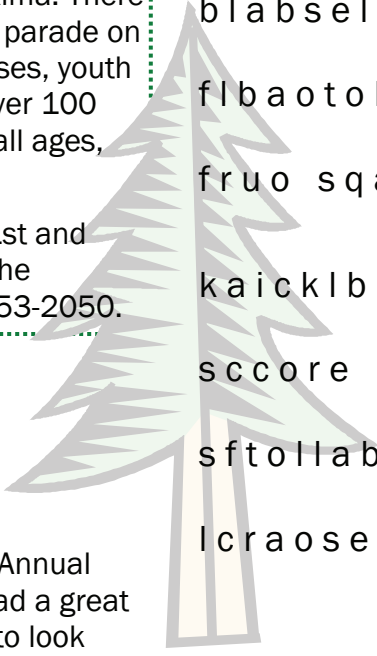
